

ANOTHER VICTORY.

Capt. McMillin Wins His Case at St.

Captain J. S. McMillin, the inventor of the steam capstan, received a dispatch from St. Louis on Saturday from his attorney, informing him that the case of Mr. McMillin et al. vs. John L. Huse et al. had been decided in his favor. This was a suit on an infringement on his patent. It was tried in the United States District Court, Justice Miller, of the U. S. Supreme Court, and Judge Treet, being on the bench. The Court decided that the McMillin patent was valid-in substance making the same decision as that made by Judge McKennan in the U. S. Circuit Court here. This is auother victory for Captain McMillin. He has had a hard fight in the Patent office and the Courts, but in every case he has won the day, and legal decisions are without exception in his favor. This last decision at St. Louis being but a corroboration of all the others, would seem to render all further centest over the right a mere waste of time and money. His legal claim to the capstan that bears his name would seem too well established to be shaken.
